This COP couldn't be more crucial. After the Paris Agreement, we are now at the deadline for translating intent into action. There were big issues outstanding after COP25 and the UK is literally in the driving seat for this. I will work cross-nationally to build alliances that put pr-essure on governments to make sure they deliver. With my network development and international

conference experience, I will build capacity and ensure we can use our international power to get results. We need an empowered youth movement and strong collaboration for this.

I'm excited for the challenges of the next two years.
